...and the need for a more holistic approach to aging research. The authors argue that the current focus on individual-level factors is insufficient and that a more comprehensive understanding of aging requires attention to the social and cultural contexts in which aging occurs. They call for a paradigm shift in gerontology that moves beyond the traditional focus on individual differences and deficits to a more holistic view of aging that recognizes the interconnectedness of the individual, the family, and the community. This new paradigm should emphasize the strengths and resources of older adults and the role of social support in promoting well-being. The authors also discuss the importance of addressing the needs of diverse populations of older adults, including those from ethnic and racial minorities, and the need for culturally sensitive research and interventions. Finally, they conclude by emphasizing the need for a more integrated and interdisciplinary approach to aging research that draws on insights from psychology, sociology, anthropology, and other disciplines.
